## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



1. We encourage artists to enter online via the TryBooking website: [www.trybooking.com/BLJTP](http://www.trybooking.com/BLJTP).

If posting your entry form, please allow 2 weeks for delivery.
3. Friday 12 February 2021 is the closing day for entries. Entries after this date will not be accepted.
4. Entry Fee of \$10 per exhibit applies but Youth Award entries are free. **Maximum of 3 entries** per artist.
5. Payment of Entry Fee can be paid by either of these methods:

  - c. **Cheques** can be made out to Rutherglen Tastes of Art Prize and mailed to above address.
6. All entries are non-acquisitive and must be recent original works of the artist. The same work may not be entered in more than one section.
7. Entries (other than sculpture) to be suitably presented ready to hang with flush hangers, labelled on back with name, title, section and price. No entries to exceed 1.2 sq m, including frame. (For example, 1.0 m x 1.2 m=1.2 sq m)  
**ALL ARTWORK MUST BE SIGNED BY ARTISTS**  
Unless entering online with [TryBooking.com/BLJTP](http://TryBooking.com/BLJTP), an entry form **MUST** be received by the due date of Friday 12 February 2021, otherwise artwork cannot be displayed.
8. Works on stretched canvas need not have additional framing, however, well-finished and clean edges are essential.
9. Artwork for 2021 must not have been exhibited at Rutherglen Tastes of Art Prize previously.
10. 3D Small Art Work entries include ceramics, metal, wood & textiles and should be no larger than 1.2 sq m, free standing and suitable for indoor and/or outdoor purposes.
11. Delivery of exhibits – Works to be delivered to the Rutherglen Memorial Hall between 10am and 5.30pm on Wednesday 3rd March 2021.
12. Please let us know if you are using an Art Courier. Here are two Couriers we can suggest:

13. Transport and insurance costs to be met by the artist. All possible care will be taken but no liability will be accepted by Arts Rutherglen for any loss or damage to exhibits.
14. If insufficient space to display all artwork, the organisers reserve the right not to display some works. Sculpture to be delivered inside the hall by the exhibitor or nominated person. The organisers reserve the right to withdraw or reclassify entries not complying with the section entered.
15. Sales & Commission – All exhibits are to be listed for sale. A commission of 20% will be charged on all sales except Youth entrants. Please consider the 20% commission when pricing your artwork as changes cannot be made.
16. The decision of the judge shall be final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding such decision.
17. The organisers reserve the right to photograph works for future promotion.
18. Award winners will be announced and presented at the official Gala Cocktail Opening Night at 6.30pm Friday 5 March 2021. Free entry to participating artists, otherwise \$15 per person.
19. Collection of exhibits – All unsold works to be collected between 4pm and 6pm Sunday 14 March 2021 (unless notified that all art works have been sold) or other arrangements have been made with the organisers.
20. For artwork sold, payment will be made within the month by Direct Deposit to your nominated Bank Account. Alternatively, arrangements can be made to pay by cheque.
21. Dates to remember:
  - i. **Friday 12th February:** Entries close.
  - ii. **Wednesday 3rd March:** Deliver art works to Rutherglen Memorial Hall from 10.00am to 5.30pm.
  - iii. **Thursday 4th March:** Judging of exhibits.
  - iv. **Friday 5th March 6.30-9.00pm:** Gala Opening Cocktail Party and winners announced.
  - v. **Sunday 14th March 4-6pm:** Collect art works (unless sold).
